Introduction


Hourigan Connolly (Chartered Town Planners) have been instructed by Keepmoat Homes to notify surrounding residents that a planning application for residential development is currently being prepared at land to the east of Howard Close in west Accrington. The site is shown above edged in a red line.

On behalf of the applicant we are undertaking a period of consultation on the draft proposals that will run until **20 March 2020**.

We are hosting a Consultation Event between 2pm and 6.30pm at Acorn Health Centre, 421 Blackburn Road, Accrington, BB5 1RT on Wednesday 11 March 2020, where you are invited to drop-in between those times and view the proposals. Members of the team from Keepmoat and Hourigan Connolly will be on hand to answer any queries you may have.

This forms part of the pre-application consultation process. All comments received will be used to inform the planning application before it is submitted to Hyndburn Borough Council.

When the planning application has been submitted, the Council will notify surrounding residents as part of their own consultation process. You will then have a further opportunity to submit comments on the proposals directly to the Council.
